



REVITALIZATION TIPS

- Have active members call non-active members to invite them to events, meetings, and special meetings.
- Hold strictly social events, dinners, game nights, and fun nights and invite non-active members.
- Invite non-active members to participate in or attend fund-raising events.
- Keep in touch with members who for some reason can't be active (let them know they matter and that someone cares). Keep them up-to-date on Chapter events. Don't forget them just because they said "no" in the past. Their circumstances may change and they'll be able to join you.
- Top line signers of petitions or members serving as mentors should keep in touch with new members to get them familiar with signs and passes, traditions, and protocol of the Chapter, and attempt to keep them as active as they are able. This is also a great opportunity for your Worthy Patron to have classes for the new members and even invite those who would like a brush-up.
- Have active members who do ask non-active members to meetings go over the signs and passes with them, especially if they feel that it might be necessary, to avoid embarrassment or hesitation about returning to chapter.
- Offer to pick up a non-active member and transport him/her to and from meetings or events.
- Hand-deliver the chapter newsletter to local shut-ins or to members who haven't been attending the meetings.
- Extra desserts after the meeting? How about delivering them tomorrow to a shut in or someone who missed the meeting. It's a great way to win over the spouse, too! How about the Master of the Lodge?
